



How to setup an email address in iOS


To set up an e-mail account on your iPhone, you will need to do the following:

- From your home screen you will need to select "Settings." Once you are on the settings screen, you will then need to select "Mail"




- From there, select "Add Account" which is located under "Accounts"

- Next, tap "Other" from your "Add Account" screen and then select "Add mail account". Here you can input your details (I.e Name, Email, Password)



- You will then need to select "IMAP" and then, from the keypad, enter your account information.



Then enter:

<p>your "Incoming Mail Server" information as follows: for the "Host Name" enter "mail.intouchsystems.co.uk"</p> <p>Then enter your complete email address as the username i.e. "test@itsadsl.net",</p> <p>and then enter your email password for the "Password."</p>	<p>Fill in the "Outgoing Mail Server (SMTP)" information as follows: for the "Host Name" enter "mail.intouchsystems.co.uk."</p> <p>Then enter your "Username" (full email address)" and "Password" as you have done for your "Incoming Mail Server" since that information is the same for both your incoming and outgoing mail.</p>
