

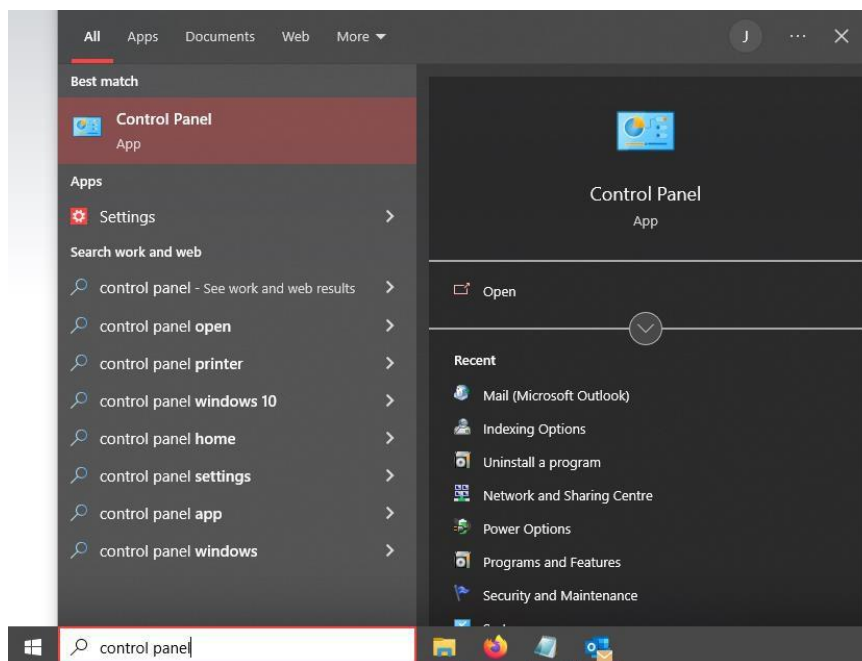
How to setup an email address in Outlook 2019

To set up an E-mail account in Microsoft Outlook 2019, you will need to do the following:

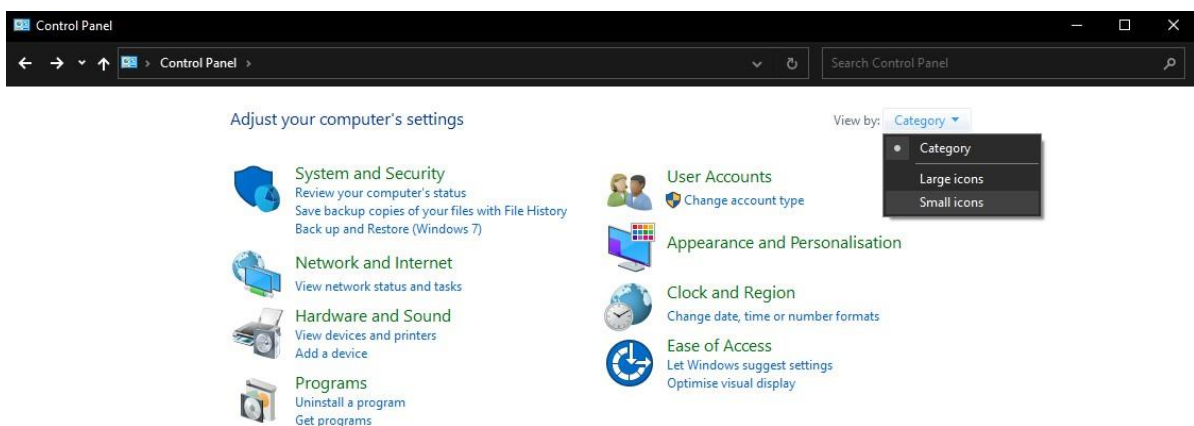
Find the search bar on the bottom left corner of your screen



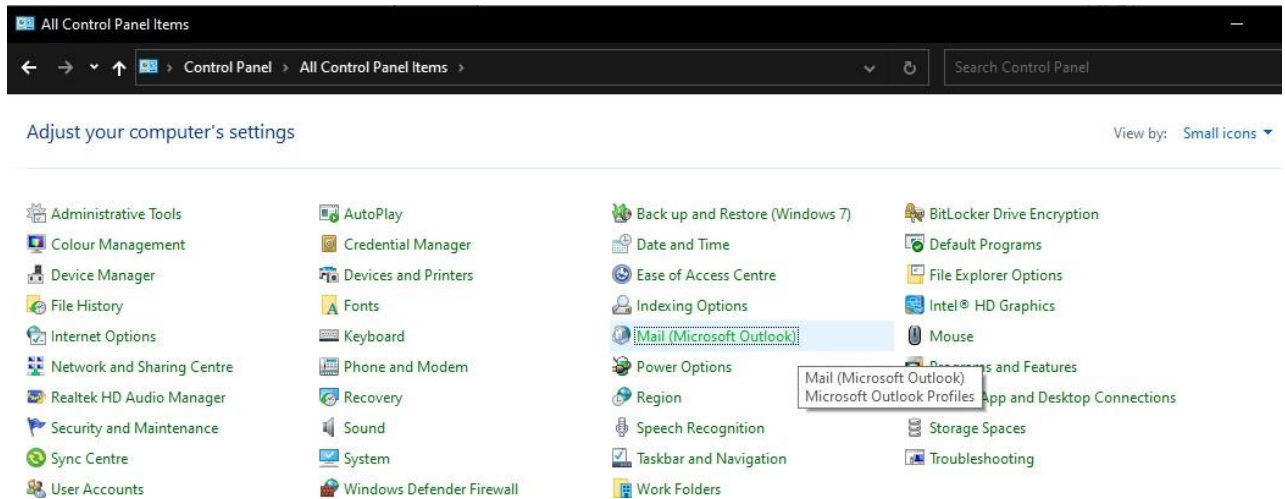
Type 'Control Panel' and open the top result



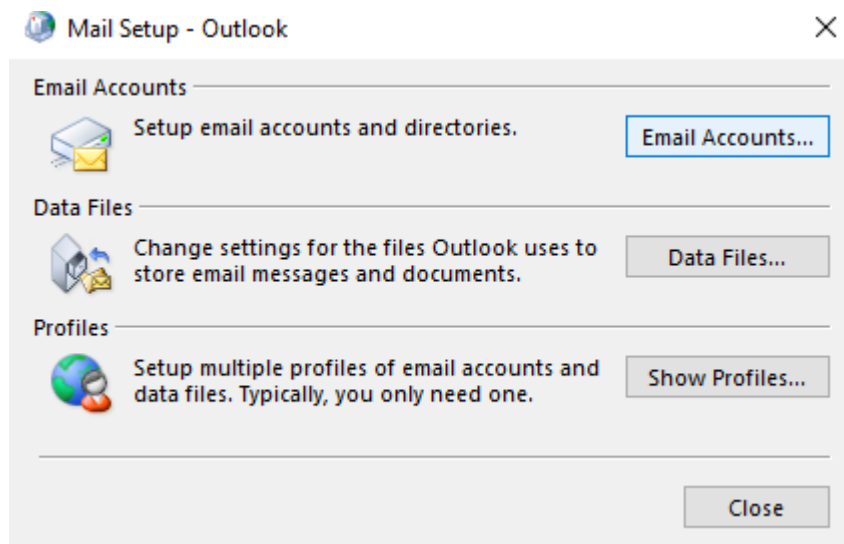
Once Open, click Category in the right corner, and click 'Small Icons'
